

RHABDOMYOLYSIS FROM RUSSULA SUBNIGRICANS

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Abstract: Mushroom poisoning is continuously reported in Thailand particularly in rainy season. The majority of patients had only mild to moderate gastrointestinal symptoms or acute hepatitis. Rhabdomyolysis caused by mushroom poisoning has rarely been reported. We report 6 cases suffering with wild mushroom (Russula Subnigricans) poisoning. Who presented with gastrointestinal symptoms, acute hepatitis and acute rhabdomyolysis, with 3 fatality. Physician should be aware of rhabdomyolysis after ingestion of wild mushroom.
