CLINICAL CASE :

A 34-year-old woman arrived at the ER with severe burning pain in the throat, epigastrium, vomiting blood, difficulty breathing and swallowing, hoarseness, and weakness. She was found in her kitchen with a strong odor present. The patient, who makes pickled vegetables for a living, refused to disclose what happened. Upon examination, she appeared pale with cold hands, low oxygen saturation (88%), rapid pulse (134 bpm), and low blood pressure (92/55 mmHg). She excreted dark cherry-colored urine and had high free hemoglobin levels (16.4 g/L, normal 1 gr/L) and arterial blood gas of pH=7.32, pCO₂=55 mmHg, hCo₃=22 mmol/L, pO₂= 61 mmHg,
