### **Young Man with Multiple Painful Erythematous Papules**

A 35-year-old male went to hiking in Pinglin, one district in the Southeast of New Taipei City in Taiwan, in the morning of September. Then he was attacked by a grouping of wasp when he passed by a forest. Physical examination 27 stings over the back, abdomen and right upper limb, with dermal necrosis. The insect later was proved as *Vespa mandarinia*. We discussed the possible mechanism of dermal necrosis(VESCP-M2) and management of wasp venom intoxication.
