Poison control center(PCC) had build up to 30 years since 1978. Not only for telephone consultation to help clinical physician to treat poisoned patients, but also help the government to store and supply the antidote to hospital who need them. Since we understand the importance of specific antidotes in the management of acute poisonings, we describe the history of the Taiwan Antidote (Stockingand Distribution) Network (TAN), and summarize past achievements and current status of TAN in Taiwan PCC.
